<u>Pepper Beer Competition</u> - Jointly hosted by Dunedin Brewers Guild and PUB Guild (Dunedin/Pinellas Park). Opens: July 1st. Entry Deadline: August 13th. Judging: August 26th.

<u>Commander SAAZ</u> - Competition Entry Opens: July 13th. Registration closes: August 23rd. Splashdown Awards Dinner: September 15th.

Oktoberfest in October – Hosted by the Suncoast Barley Mashers. Limited to German beers, capped at 200 entries. Entry open until October 5th. Judging/Awards: October 20th.

<u>Walk the Line With Barleywine</u> - Hosted by Dunedin Brewers Guild. Entry deadline November 23. Competition Date: December 1. Only seven categories, and many are styles you'd start brewing NOW.

Final BUBR Donation Results



Once the full financial accounting was complete on this year's Bottoms Up Beer Run, SAAZ was able to make a \$6000 donation to St. Baldrick's Foundation to support of pediatric cancer research. SAAZ Prez Brian Cavins also collected \$810 in donations for his head shave, bringing the total contribution to \$6810.
