<u>Commander SAAZ</u> - Competition Entry Opens: July 13<sup>th</sup>. Registration closes: August 23<sup>rd</sup>. Splashdown Awards Dinner: September 15<sup>th</sup>. First four entries for SAAZ members are free. Contact Anne Gregg if you were charged and would like reimbursement.

<u>Best Florida Beer Homebrew Competition</u> – Entry Opens: August 20. Entry Closes: September 26. Entry Delivery Deadline: September 26. Awards: October 20

Oktoberfest in October – Hosted by the Suncoast Barley Mashers (Clearwater). Limited to German beers, capped at 200 entries. Entry open until October 5<sup>th</sup>. Awards: October 20<sup>th</sup>.

<u>Walk the Line with Barleywine</u> - Hosted by Dunedin Brewers Guild. Entry deadline November 23. Competition Date: December 1. Only seven categories.
