Officer Meeting Highlights

- Paul Sorice (PUBGuild) took SAAZ entries over to Best Florida Beer Competition for us.
- November beach bonfire still on, but location and time still TBD, as permitting/reservations have not opened up yet for the year.
- New casual social event for November prior to the Officers Meeting at club Platinum Sponsor, Broken Barrel Tavern in Palm Bay.
- Commander SAAZ weekend debrief
 - o 2019 venue still TBD Need to compare terms, prices and venue suitability.
 - Will create a post-event survey and send to all attendees and volunteers.
 - Bottle sorting, entry storage and pace of judging went well. Unlike previous years, had plenty of judges this year, but far too few stewards. Need to highly promote stewarding among members and friends of the club since this requires no previous experience and can be quickly learned.
 - Excellent support from out-of-town judges. We need to reciprocate when other clubs have competitions. Plan is to put more emphasis on training new judges within the club over the next year. We have some advanced judges who can help with this.
 - Received lots of good feedback regarding the event being fun. Twitter wall seemed to be enjoyed. After an initial glitch, live stream worked well and we were able to quickly post the new link to multiple locations.
 - Some repeat award recipients did not appreciate having to stop for a photo each time they went up to receive a medal. Also, those accepting on behalf of others did not always want photos. Make this optional next year.
 - O More key volunteer positions need to be defined and filled well in advance of next year's event, and entire club needs to be involved. Had some great volunteers this year, but too few of them which left a lot of work for the small core group. Still lots of fun and great camaraderie, but exhausting!
 - o A more detailed timeline and more detailed checklists next year should make things easier and more relaxed for volunteers.




We can't possibly do an adequate job of capturing everything about the competition and event weekend, but here's a brief summary.

- We sorted and judged over 550 competition entries over three weekends (that's almost 1700 bottles of homebrew!) This wouldn't have been possible without participation from our members and the help of our friends from other brew clubs. Medals were awarded in 41 categories.
- We hosted three events on Commander SAAZ weekend, the traditional Commander's Call Beer Fest that included a People's Choice keg competition with a lineup of fantastic brews from some of our local breweries, the (new this year) Re-Entry Social & Trivia event at Florida Beer Company, and the Splashdown Dinner and Awards Ceremony.
- We played up the space theme this year by providing a space backdrop and props for photos and promoting the NASA Selfie App, as well as including some themed décor and effects at the Splashdown dinner. We also projected a tweet wall during the Splashdown and invited everyone to tweet their photos, witty (?) comments and congratulations.
