- Spring Party and SAAZtoberfest locations confirmed
- Election
 - Reach out to people this week to firm up candidates (already in place for Prez, VP).
 - SAAZ Ambassador as a position (project chair or officer)? Have this position take care of swag and sponsorships and maintaining relationship with local breweries.
 - Competition Coordinator needed to pass timely information to brewers, including notice of upcoming comps, when to brew what style for an upcoming comp, coordinate railroads and shipping of entries (project chair or officer position?).
 - Change of officer positions require by-laws change, which will need to be voted upon at January meeting with notice to members.
 - Change name of Newsletter Editor to Communications Officer since it includes webmaster duties and can encompass social media duties Requires bylaws edit.
 - Email election ballots to all paid members. Deadline for emailing completed ballot is 4PM on December 15. Live balloting will occur at Christmas party.
- External competitions Need to coordinate better with other clubs for railroad and try to work with them to establish consistent rules for circuit comps.
- SAAZ lifetime family membership requested by some current members.
 - Need to establish and advertise more well-defined conditions.
 - Named members in the same household, non-transferable
- Bonfire New tentative date is February 8th
- Review meeting schedule and locations to optimize venue usage i.e., outside venues in cooler months, inside air-conditioned locations in hotter months
- Binders being created for officer positions to preserve "corporate knowledge"
- January transitional officer mtg scheduled



By-Laws Change Notice

We will be voting on the following By-Laws changes at the January 2019 meeting. Some updates to the wording may occur at the January Officers meeting, but members will have two weeks' notice prior to the meeting to review the final wording.

Creating an officer position for Sponsorship and Swag referred to as SAAZ Ambassador. Duties include:

- Maintaining club sponsorship records and requests
- Communicating with event and club sponsors
- Coordinating sponsors for club swag/ raffles
- Coordinating with officer board for event sponsorship and raffles
- Maintaining inventory of club swag and raffle items

Changing the name of the office of "Webmaster" to "Communication Director" to encompass all social media and communication related activities including:

- Maintaining Facebook Events and calendar
- Maintaining Club web pages and social media accounts as relevant and up to date
- Maintaining SAAZ MOZEO texting service

Officially changing the name of the "Librarian" to club "Historian." Duties Include:

- Keeping and maintaining periodicals and books hereby known as the "library"
- Maintaining club records and archives from past events (photos, articles, and past years information)
- Maintaining an inventory of club equipment and goods (storage unit)
- Default chairperson for the education committee
- Education coordinator or presenter at club meetings
- Coordinator for club documentation of events (photographers etc.)
